Thank you for your interest in volunteering with Habitat...

We always need volunteers!

Workdays: Tues - Sat, 8:30 am - 3:30 pm, year-round!

What a volunteer needs to know:

-  Wear comfortable work clothes and work boots. A hat and safety glasses will be provided. Dust mask and ear plugs may also be required and will be available at work site. Sun-screen and lightweight raincoat/poncho may be needed.
-  Due to a limited number of hand tools, it is wonderful if volunteers can bring hammers, nail aprons, and work gloves with them to the construction site. Please be sure to label these with your name, as many tools look alike.
-  Occasionally lunch is provided by local churches or restaurants. Drinking water will be provided at each worksite throughout the day.
-  Volunteers are responsible for their own transportation.

What a volunteer may do:

NO PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE NECESSARY! We'll teach you . . . under the direction of qualified construction management, volunteers will participate in framing, roofing, vinyl siding installation, painting, landscaping, door, window and hardware installation, and cleanup.

Safety first:

Please keep in mind that our sites are construction sites, and the safety of all participants is our first priority. *All volunteers, regardless of age or past participation, must sign a waiver annually.* **All volunteers are required to sign in at the worksite each work day.**

Volunteers age 16-17 are allowed to hammer, paint, landscape, and clean-up.

Volunteers 14-15 are allowed to pick up and landscape.

Volunteers under the age of 14 are unfortunately not allowed on the worksites.

Individuals are welcome to join us any time we are building, just call the day before to find out where we'll be. *To find out when and where we're building, please call:*
